



GOING INTO YOUR DRAFT OR AUCTION WITH A WELL-THOUGHT-OUT PLAN WILL GO A LONG WAY

It seems like every facet of life involves some sort of strategy. In games of the heart, acting like you don't want a woman is a sure way to attract her. To dodge morning traffic, you've come to realize that if you leave your house at 8 a.m., you'll get to work at 8:30 but if you leave at 8:05, you'll arrive at 9:20. And when attacking a buffet, you never go for the salad bar or breads — it's always straight to the meat and pasta.

Fantasy Baseball is no different — and this column is to help show you the way through several different formats. Whether you are a 10-year Fantasy vet or a first-timer, you should be able to glean at least a couple of useful tips.

Here are some strategies used on Draft Day:

Learn from recent history

Last season continued a recent trend in baseball that showed pitching takes a backseat to hitting. Fantasy owners are well aware of the fickle production gained from their pitchers — especially closers — but have we learned enough to adjust our thinking on Draft Day? In 2006, no pitcher was able to win 20 games for the first time in more than a decade. As a matter of fact, the last time it happened was in 1995, which happened to be the first year back after a work stoppage.

It wasn't much better in 2007. Only Josh Beckett was able to win 20 games. But there were five 19-game winners and four 18-game winners. There were only three hurlers with more than 17 wins in '06, so there was some improvement. The fact that Beckett won 20 games in just 30 starts is even more impressive. What you want to think about going into this spring's drafts is that the elite pitchers category has expanded beyond just Johan Santana. You can wait on this position and still end up with a category stud like Aaron Harang (Ks), Dan Haren (ERA), C.C. Sabathia (WHIP) and Chien-Ming Wang (wins).

We know that the days of grabbing Randy Johnson, Pedro Martinez and Curt Schilling in the early rounds is long behind us, and now it seems there's a much larger group of pitchers to choose from. The '06 rookie class was a stellar one, and now they are entering their third year as starters in the majors which is usually a good indicator of a breakout season.

The closer position continues to be a forever changing landscape. You can wait here as well. Outside of Jonathan Papelbon, Francisco Rodriguez and maybe J.J. Putz, you can mix and match the next eight or so relievers. As a matter of fact, of the 133 relievers that recorded a save last year, only 32 were among the top 276 players in our average draft rankings (12 teams, 23 player rosters). There were 11 relievers that posted double-digit saves that went undrafted in most leagues - led by Cincinnati's David Weathers (33), Florida's Kevin Gregg (32) and Toronto's Jeremy Accardo (30).

The point is that the closer position is always in flux, and you should be able to take a chance on a couple late in the draft, or even fix in Fantasy free agency.

Big boppers and speed demons

From a hitting perspective, we saw the power categories take a dip again. It seems like we are in a high-low roller coaster between even and odd years. In 2004, there were 37 hitters with at least 30 homers, dropping down to 27 in '05, back up to 34 in '06, then back down again in '07 to just 26 — the fewest total of 30-homer hitters since the '95 season.

A total of 500 more homers were hit in 2006 compared to 2005, but there was a drop of more than 200 last season. This dip in power makes the sluggers a little more valuable this season, since they will be supplying thinner categories than usual. Note: Vlad Guerrero's 27 homers in 150 games is his lowest HR-per-games played total since 1997, his rookie year. He should rejoin the 30-home run hitters club this year. The decline of power translated over to the speed categories, as there were 42 hitters that swiped at least 20 bases in 2007, up from 35 in '06 and 27 in both '05 and '04. That's the most 20-base stealers since 2001.

What does all this mean to a Fantasy owner? It means you can wait a little bit on steals and bulk up on extra power since SBs are no longer as rare and valuable. Note: Chone Figgins had 41 steals (his lowest number since '04) in only 442 at-bats because of two fractured fingers. He's a player to target for an increase in stolen bases.

Draft Strategies

In "The Art of War," Sun Tzu wrote, "If you know both yourself and your enemy, you can come out of hundreds of battles without danger." That advice also works in Fantasy play. If you are playing against seasoned Fantasy veterans, you have to be careful with your approach. If you are up against rookies, you can take more chances and expect to be able to recover.

But where you take those risks is important no matter who your competition is. The first round of your draft is no place to gamble on an oft-injured player or a highly touted rookie. This is where you want to build a solid Fantasy foundation. The top picks are for either slugging studs (Alex Rodriguez) or stolen-base saviors (Jose Reyes). If you don't pick until the middle or the end of the first round, you'll be deciding between

multi-faceted players like Jimmy Rollins, Alfonso Soriano or David Wright. Also, toward the back end of the first round, you could have your choice of a pair of players you are targeting, forcing your first big decision.

With that in mind, consider the team(s) you are sandwiched around. You might end up with both players if you work it right. If you know an owner selecting near you is a Marlins or Tigers fan, he'll likely snatch up Miguel Cabrera if you don't. Young players are risky propositions early on. Granted, if you had the foresight to take Ryan Howard early in 2006 or Prince Fielder early in '07, you likely made out like a bandit. Does that give you enough ammunition to take Ryan Braun, last season's top rookie, in the first round this year? He'd make a better second-round pick than first if you can wait.

As far as rookies entering this season, like Jay Bruce, Evan Longoria and Joey Votto, feel free to take a flier on them if you have a relatively risk-free lineup in place. You might have to reserve them for a month, like Braun and Hunter Pence last season, but you saw how that paid off.

One thing to remember about young players is that those that progress in their second season are usually the ones that hit well in the second half of their rookie seasons. The first time around, pitchers are still learning how to get them out — but the second time, they know the hitter's weaknesses. If that rookie hitter can make the correct adjustments and still get his hits in, then his chances of succeeding in Year Two are even better. Among the veterans, you'll want to target guys that you expect will rebound or emerge. In other words, you don't want to put too much credence in what they did last year. Think about Rickie Weeks and J.D. Drew, both of whom were happier than most of us when '07 turned to '08. Weeks shook off a wrist injury and

demotion to the minors before finishing strong. He hit .273, with 11 homers and 15 steals in his last 43 games. Drew had a horrible first year in the AL, but he's still a talented hitter that has now stayed healthy for two straight seasons. Swoop in and take advantage of lowrisk/high-reward players like this.

Hitting usually is a little more valuable than pitching in Rotisserie play for several reasons. There are 14 hitters on a standard roster, compared to just nine pitchers. And most pitchers can only affect four categories at best, while position players can produce stats in all five hitting categories. So, especially in mixed leagues, consider waiting on pitching. You'll be surprised what kind of staff you can put together. That theory was put to the test in a few mock drafts I did earlier this offseason. Your position players will be much stronger. While others are picking a second starter, you can stash away a 35-HR hitter or a 40-base stealer.

Once again, there's not much position flexibility this season. While there are two players eligible at four positions (Willie Bloomquist and Mark Loretta), there really aren't many great twoposition players. Carlos Guillen (1B/ SS) and B.J. Upton (2B/OF) are the best of the bunch because they have middle-infield eligibility. Granted, that's not a reason to draft them over a better hitter necessarily, but that flexibility can be helpful, especially if you end up with David

Ortiz or Travis Hafner occupying your DH spot.

Head-to-Head play

Rotisserie owners have had to make room for Head-to-Head owners over the past decade, as Fantasy Football has invaded the landscape. While the scoring systems vary, it's safe to say that most formats rely mainly on starting pitching and home run hitters. So when you are trying to decide between a slugger and a slap-hitter — go for the former. Also, check your rules to see if your league deducts points for strikeouts. If so, the difference between Carlos Lee (32 HR, 63 K) and Miguel Cabrera (33 HR, 127 K) is much greater than just the one home run.

Leadoff hitters are also strong H2H players because of the abundance of at-bats they receive. So players like Jose Reyes, Grady Sizemore and Chris B. Young are above-average players. (Don't forget that Young struck out 141 times though, if you are in that type of league.) Another item to check your rules for: Do you have to start starting pitchers and relievers or just pitchers as one general category? If you have to start relievers, and starters generally score more points in your league, then target someone like Chad Billingsley, who is eligible as a reliever, but will start for the Dodgers. He gives you strong position flexibility there. Zack Greinke and Joba Chamberlain are similar players. Move them up a few spots in your rankings because of this flexibility.

Auction Drafts

If you have never done an auction, you should really consider starting a new league to go with your straight-draft league. The nuances and differences in strategy compared to the straight drafts are numerous. And really, it's a much more fair way of dispersing players among Fantasy teams. If you want A-Rod, you can have him — you just have to bid more than everyone else.

In an auction, try to set a budget (with a \$260 salary cap usually) for premium players (power hitters, 30-30 guys, topshelf closers and pitching aces). And realize you won't need to spend much on your second catcher, middle infielder and DH if you don't want to — there are enough of those to go around.

If you don't go on a spending spree early, buying up every big-money player, you should be able to gather up some great bargains in the latter portions of the auction. Use our dollar values as a guideline, but feel free to go up or down a few dollars, depending on how your opponents are spending their money and your own roster needs.

Live auction drafting is very similar to a poker game. You can play up your opponents and watch for their tells, letting you know when they are about to back out on a bidding war. Talk up players you hate and keep quiet about players you like.

On that same subject, vary your own bidding style. Return the bid quickly sometimes, while waiting until the last second other times. If you always bid a certain way, your opponent will have a better idea if you are planning on bailing on the next bid or if you are going to run the price up to the stratosphere.

And don't underestimate the mystique of the number nine. If you are in a \$1 back-and-forth bidding war on a player, instead of bidding \$18 on a player after his \$17 bid, go straight to \$19. He or she will think longer and harder about saying \$20 than they would in just saying \$19. It's that step into the 20s that throws them off.

Draft Day is not when champions are crowned

The Scottish poet Robert Burns once wrote, "The best-laid plans of mice and men go oft awry." Sounds like Burns has been at the wrong end of a run on closers. Whatever happens in your draft, remember this: You have the whole season in front of you to right your wrongs. Unfortunately, it also means you have six months to undo what good you've done. Stay active on the waiver wire and don't be afraid to pull the trigger on a trade a month into the season. Winners work, while losers watch.

IT'S NO COINCIDENCE 27-YEAR OLDS CONSISTENTLY BREAK OUT AND THIRD-YEAR STARTING PITCHERS BREAK THROUGH.

The Rockies were surprising World Series participants. The Red Sox were surprisingly dominant from start to finish. Yet, we were not surprised how everything was decided last year.

Josh Beckett won another postseason MVP award and would have won his first Cy Young if not for C.C. Sabathia winning his first. Burgeoning superstar Matt Holliday nearly rose up to win the NL MVP, leading his team — along with ace Jeff Francis — to a thrilling onegame playoff win and into the postseason, only to be outdone by Beckett's Red Sox.

Beckett, Sabathia and Holliday baseball heroes last season and breakthrough superstars that led their teams into the final four. They also had something more significant in common: They each were 27 years old. Francis, now 27 himself, was a starting pitcher in his third year. They all performed better last year than we had seen them in years prior. The weight of past numbers is generally how the public rates players going into the next year (much to our dismay), when in actuality, you want to draft this year's Fantasy team, not last year's. If you have followed our analysis on CBSSports.com in recent years, and yours truly in particular, you know we take great pride in uncovering players who haven't peaked. You also know plenty about why 27-year-olds and third-year starting pitchers are potential breakthrough candidates.

This year's crop of 27-year-olds and third-year starters is as exciting as any. Here are our top 10 players in each category who have yet to show us their best and who we expect to do so this year. In many cases, like a stock that has yet to mature, picking these guys up on Draft Day will give you more bang for your buck.

HITTERS

The theory behind 27-year-old breakouts is based on medical research that suggests a man's body reaches its physical peak at that age. Also, after years of seasoning and pro experience everything comes together for career highs across the board. Granted, there are exceptions to every rule. For instance: Bobby Crosby was 27 last year and arguably as worthless as we have ever seen him. Dan Johnson, Chad Tracy and Chris Burke were all 27, too, and nearly equally worthless.

But you can't argue with nature and science. The strategy of picking hitters entering their prime physical years is a great one when you are trying to choose between a veteran in decline (Gary Sheffield) or a comparable player, statistically, who is now just 27 and yet to look like an MVP (see No. 1 here).

Note: all of the players mentioned here are either 27 on opening day or will turn that age during the season.

1. ALEX RIOS | OF | BLUE JAYS

CAREER HIGHS: .302 AVG, 24 HR, 85 RBI, 114 R, SB 17

You might not know this, but Rios was once the best prospect in baseball and considered a 30-30 candidate. It has taken him four years to get to the .300- 25-85-115-20 level. But, since he is 27 this spring, this should be the year he completely busts out. We have seen glimpses of greatness, but a favorite theory of ours is that streaky young hitters become superstars. With age and experience, those hot streaks get longer and the cold streaks get shorter.

And, if you have paid attention to detail, the "next Dave Winfield" has filled out on his 6-foot-5 frame. Once a tall, skinny outfielder who homered just one time in his first year (426 at-bats), Rios has become a behemoth — and a Home Run Derby participant. There was a very good reason the Giants actually were considering dealing

Tim Lincecum for Rios this winter. You might see a nice mid-round pick. We see a future MVP. Like Holliday before him, Rios could wind up being a Fantasy firstrounder after his age-27 season.

2. CURTIS GRANDERSON | OF | TIGERS

CAREER HIGHS: .302-23-74-122-26

Speaking of skinny outfielders with some outstanding projectability, we have Granderson, who set every one of his career highs last year. He was also just the third player in history to get at least 20 homers, 20 doubles, 20 triples and 20 stolen bases in a season. And he is not done getting better. We would not be surprised to see Granderson rise to 30 homers, 30 doubles and 30 steals.

Throw in the fact the Tigers have added Miguel Cabrera and Edgar Renteria to their already stacked lineup and you have some very good reasons to take Granderson among the top 10 outfielders off the board on Draft Day, especially in Rotisserie leagues where speedand-power players are at a premium.

3. ROCCO BALDELLI | OF | RAYS

CAREER HIGHS: .302-16-78-89-27

The player who has become known as Rocco Bal-DL-i enters another spring with uncertainty surrounding his health

(mostly his legs, most recently his hamstring). You see caution flags.We see a tremendous sleeper opportunity.

Like our theories on 27s and third-year starters, we also find diamonds in the rough on players who are downgraded

due to injury questions. Someone in your league will reluctantly pick Baldelli after 40-plus outfielders are off the

board. That team just might have the key piece to win your league. If Baldelli is healthy enough at 27 to reach even his previous career highs, he will perform like a top-20 outfielder. He is capable of much more, a true high-reward guy available to you in the middle rounds.

4. HANK BLALOCK | 3B | RANGERS

CAREER HIGHS: .300-32-110-107-4

Another player who will be seriously downgraded due to injury woes, Blalock seems like the oldest 27-year-old on the list. He has been around for six years and just turned 27 this November.

The question is how well did his shoulder surgery go last year?

Apparently, smashing. Blalock hit .313 with five homers, a .404 OBP and a .656 SLUG when he returned in September.

Shoulders are the trickiest and scariest injuries for a slugger. You can play with a sore shoulder. You won't be anywhere near your best, though. Clearly, Blalock hasn't been since 2005, when he was once a lock for 25-plus homers, 90-plus RBI and 80-plus runs. He couldn't have possibly peaked at 23, could he?

5. CHRIS DUNCAN | OF | CARDINALS

CAREER HIGHS: .293-22-70-60-2

Yet another bad-news, good-news injuryrisk sleeper. Before coming down with a sports hernia that eventually

required season-ending surgery, Duncan was hitting .294 on July 26 with 20 of his 21 homers. He played through the injury, sparingly, before shutting it down, hitting just .167 (15-for-90) in August and September. Duncan finished the first half .288-16- 47-40 and came out of the break smoking hot. We have yet to see him in a full season, so he could be a pleasant surprise for Fantasy owners this year.

6. JOSH HAMILTON | OF | RANGERS

CAREER HIGHS: .292-19-47-52-3

Someone with the Marlins told us last spring to watch out for Hamilton with the Reds. We said, sure, nice story of a Rule-5 pick coming out of drug addiction to have a nice spring and make the team. We even upgraded our projections some.

But we still fell short on what Hamilton accomplished as a rookie and that person above wound up laughing at us for not listening close enough. For our sake, Hamilton did slow down some due to injury (wrist and hamstring). But for yours, he will come cheaper than he should on Draft Day.

There was a very good reason Hamilton was the No. 1 overall pick in 1999. And he showed it in parts of last year, hitting 19 homers in just 298 at-bats. In his first full season of 500 at-bats, 25-30 homers is certainly reachable.

He might even be capable of 40 homers.

7. RYAN GARKO | 1B | INDIANS

CAREER HIGHS: .292-21-61-62-0

What you have seen from Garko might not impress you much, especially at the deep first base position, but last

year was ostensibly his rookie year. He still has plenty of room to grow into a Fantasy cornerstone.Our optimistic projections rank him around the 15th best at his position. We would not be surprised to see him develop into a .300-30-100-100 thumper as soon as this year. Garko's moderate run production last year will have him come cheap on Draft Day and he should easily beat his career bests in that productive Indians lineup.

8. KEVIN KOUZMANOFF | 3B | PADRES

CAREER HIGHS: .275-18-74-57-1

Like Hamilton and Garko (sort of), the Kouz is another category of sleeper we like: the overlooked sophomore. The theory

there is we have seen something from a rookie, most of which didn't necessarily excite us, so we tend to undervalue their potential to improve dramatically in the second year.

The Kouz's overall numbers among third baseman are average or below for most leagues, but check out what he did

in the second half and you might be more excited: .317-11-37-34-1 (.366 OBP, .524 SLUG). His second chance after the

All-Star break showed dramatic improvement from his first trip around the league: .228-7-37-23-0 (.290-.384).

At age 27 and with a full year under his belt should mean even more strides to becoming a reliable Fantasy option for all leagues.

9. CHRIS SNYDER | C | DIAMONDBACKS

CAREER HIGHS: .277-13-47-37-0

We keep tying these together somehow and Snyder, like the Kouz, is another one who showed great promise in the

second half. After another disappointing start to the year — .212-7-16-19-0 (.298-.364) before the break — we were about to give up on Snyder as a potential top-10 Fantasy catcher.

Rookie Miguel Montero, who has more power potential, was challenging him for atbats and Snyder wasn't doing anything to pull away — until after the All- Star break. He helped lead the D-Backs to the postseason, stabilizing the pitching

staff and going .292-6-31-18-0 (.386- .503) in the second half.

Snyder is a big man with offensive potential that wasn't apparent to most of us until the final 8-10 weeks. Assuming his glove and handling of the staff keep him in the lineup more than Montero, Snyder can develop into that top-10 catcher we thought he could be.

10. RYAN DOUMIT | C/OF | PIRATES

CAREER HIGHS: .274-9-35-33-2

Doumit has no starting job, playing the role of backup catcher to fellow 27-year-old Ronny Paulino and part-time outfielder. But he retains catcher eligibility in Fantasy and has a great bat. He went .305-6-21-22-1 (.381-.509) in the first half last year, before becoming a walking infirmary (hamstring, wrist and ankle injuries) and struggling to stay healthy and in the lineup after the break. His bad second half should bring down his value, but his offensive potential at a weak position will come in handy in many leagues this season.

The lowly Pirates need to play good players and Doumit is one of their better ones, so we think he will prove to be a full-timer before the end of the year.

Other 27s we haven't seen the best of yet and could be in line for career years: UTL Jeff Baker, COL; 3B Jose Bautista, PIT; OF Jason Botts, TEX; C John Buck, KC; OF Nelson Cruz, TEX; OF Jonny Gomes, TB; 2B Brendan Harris, MIN; 1B Mike Jacobs, FLA; OF Austin Kearns, CIN; 3B Dallas McPherson, FA; OF Cody Ross, FLA; 1B Chris Shelton, TEX; OF/1B Nick Swisher, CHW; OF Mark Teahen, KC; OF Shane Victorino, PHI.

STARTING PITCHERS

Pitchers can reach their physical peak at 27, too, but pitching is more art than skill and it isn't only about physical prowess. It also takes a conditioning process that requires you to build up to the 200-inning, 34-start grind.

So with that in mind, we have another way to outline potential breakouts at the riskiest position in Fantasy: Starting pitchers in their third year — or more loosely interpreted, those with between 40 and 70 career starts are conditioned and ready to pop. In the good way, not the blown ligament way. This year's crop is the best we have seen in years, mostly a result of a 2006 rookie class that was legendary.

To win your league, you want players who outproduce their draft position or auction price. Here is our top 10 "Thirdyear SPs" to target (with their age on opening day):

1. JERED WEAVER | 25 | ANGELS

Among the 30 or so arms in this category, Weaver has the lowest career ERA at 3.33. He also has the second-best WHIP at 1.232, tied for third-most victories (24) and has the fewest losses (nine). His career .250 batting-average against is nothing to sneeze at either.

Yeah, Weaver is a winner. And he has a great team in the Angels to get him run support and victories this year.

Unlike the next two elite arms on this list, he will be ranked out of the top 15 starting pitchers to target on Draft Day and won't be considered the ace of his own team. That would be John Lackey. We like Weaver's potential to perform on the level of anyone in 2008.

2. JUSTIN VERLANDER | 25 | TIGERS

OK, we know what you're saying: Way to go out on a limb with this one. Well, you're right. Verlander is a clear Fantasy ace that might be among the top five at the position already. His 35 career victories are already 10 more than the next closest third-year starter, while his ERA (3.74) is fourth best. But he is the only pitcher we project to win 20 games in 2008 for a beefed-up Tigers team that figures to have him on cruise control for your Fantasy team.

The jump from 18 victories to 20 is a significant one, and one that can net him the Cy Young in his third year.

3. COLE HAMELS | 24 | PHILLIES

You must be thoroughly annoyed now. We have yet to tell you something you don't already know. Hamels is a star for

a great team, too. His career 1.175 WHIP tops all third-year starters and his .237 BAA is good for fourth.

But, what you don't necessarily realize is Hamels, like Weaver above, has yet to break the 200-inning mark in the majors. Getting to that point should mean some big-time numbers across the board we haven't seen from him yet.

4. JOHN MAINE | 26 | METS

A much-less obvious Fantasy ace, perhaps — Maine's career ERA (4.19) won't excite you, neither will his 1.287 WHIP.

And his post-break numbers in 2007 of 5-6, 5.93 will downright scare you. He wore down in August (2-3, 6.32)

and September (1-2, 5.93), like most of his choking Mets 'mates. But what he did on the penultimate day of the season

is what he is capable of: 7 2/3 innings, one hit, 14 strikeouts. He flirted with a no-hitter, four outs away, as the Mets flirted with historic disaster.

Here's more good news: His .233 BAA is better than all those aces above him here and good for second-best among all the third-year starters (see our No. 5). And, drum roll, he turns 27 in May. Sleeper synergy that is just too perfect.

The offensively capable Mets should make him a big-time winner, and he should be able to stretch out better through the second half this time around. Last year was really his first full year in the majors after a couple of half seasons prior to 2007.

5. MATT CAIN | 23 | GIANTS

The youngest third-year starting pitcher this year works for a bad Giants ballclub that won't score many runs.

That is the real reason he has lost more games than anyone in this category (29) and was a 16-game loser last season.

Yes, we manage to hype a 16-game loser!

Heck, we rank this "loser" just outside the top 30 starters in Fantasy — for good reason. His .221 BAA is stuff of legends and his 3.73 ERA is better than all but Weaver and Hamels among this group. He has walked more batters than anyone in this category (185), but he is second among them in strikeouts (372) and we should remind you he is the youngest of this group, with plenty of room to grow.

6. RICH HILL | 27 | CUBS

If we have ingrained you properly, you paused and smiled when you saw the age next to his name. Hill is somewhat of a lateblooming lefty, which southpaws tend to be. He has the third-best career BAA (.235), albeit with a high ERA (4.39) and

just 17 victories in 52 starts. Entering his prime, and with a couple of years under his belt, he should put it all together for a Cubs team that figures to help him win a lot of games. He might even fan more than 200 batters.

7. JAMES SHIELDS | 26 | RAYS

Shields might have already celebrated his breakthrough last year, quietly becoming a reliable Fantasy option

despite pitching for one of the worst teams in baseball. The fact that he is entering his third year suggests there is

even more to come. Shields' career 1.228 WHIP is second to only Hamels in this category, mostly because he has walked just 74 batters in 339 2/3 innings. He started to strike them out, too, last year.

Sure, the Rays look like a poor team now, but they are oozing with elite talent and Shields will be among the reasons they surprise many this season.

8. PIRATES PITCHING STAFF

LH Tom Gorzelanny, 25, RH Ian Snell, 26, LH Zach Duke, 24, and LH Paul Maholm, 25, won't evoke images of the Braves' terrific early '90s trio of Tom Glavine, John Smoltz and Steve Avery, but they are arguably the best set of young arms to arrive in unison since then.

They are all in this third-year category and each has something going for him, albeit for a bad team. Gorzelanny has the best assortment of stuff, Snell throws the hardest, Duke has the best polish, while we will merely say Maholm is the craftiest. Snell, with his consistent mid-90s heat, has struck out more batters than all of the names in this category.

He has also pitched the most innings. The fact they pitch for the Pirates is good news in our book, because it will actually allow them to slip some on Draft Day.

9. BOOF BONSER AND SCOTT BAKER I 26 I TWINS

Another cheap way out, combo pick here. Baker, the control-and-command guy, will turn 27 this September, while Bonser, more of a knockout guy, turns that age just after the season. The retooling Twins are expected to count on both of these third-year arms. Baker is a strike-thrower, having walked a mere 59 batters in 280 2/3 innings. Bonser is more of a bat-misser we like to see in Fantasy.

Although the Twins don't figure to truly contend, Justin Morneau (27, by the way) and Joe Mauer figure to help make this a pair of right-handed sleepers this season.

10. SCOTT OLSEN | 24 | MARLINS

We are not sold on this left-hander's makeup — he is a hothead whose temper tends to get him in trouble with teammates, management and even police. But perhaps his anger and cockiness could be put to better use this season.

It might have to, because he enters spring as the Marlins' possible No. 1.

That is like being called the smartest dummy, though, because they are rebuild-

ing again and figure to be a last-place team. Olsen is the second-youngest thirdyear starter, but he has the fourth-most strikeouts and innings in the category.

His age will be our excuse for his past indiscretions and his talent is our reason for liking him as a sleeper in deeper leagues.

Others with 40-70 career starts who we expect to be their best yet: RH Zack Greinke, KC; RH Sergio Mitre, FLA; RH Edwin Jackson, TB; LH Chuck James, ATL; RH Kyle Davies, KC; LH Sean Marshall, CHC; LH Gustavo Chacin, TOR and RH Brandon Backe, HOU.
