Highlights

Sharp Shooting for Nanooks: Alaska Fairbanks secured the three-peat with a dominating performance at the NCAA Rifle Championships March 8-10 in Columbus, Ohio. It is the fourth title for the Nanooks.

The winning team of Matthew Emmons, Melissa Mulloy, Per Sandberg and Karl Olsson won both the smallbore and air rifle team events to claim a total of 6,283 points.

Kentucky took a narrow one-point lead over West Virginia to claim second place with a total of 6,175.

Emmons claimed the smallbore and air rifle titles for himself in the individual competitions. His Nanook teammates Sandberg and Olsson finished second and third, respectively, in smallbore. Nebraska's Amanda Trujillo finished second in the air rifle competition, while Tennessee Tech's Maxim Shub and Xavier's Thrine Kane tied for third.
